Simultaneously, he worked for four years with the company and have been touring internationally with various

projects. During that period, Julien Josse got in touch with improvisation, contemporary, composition, ... and his appetite to learn and experiment got bigger.

In 2006, Julien Josse was the winner of the International Young Talent Contest and one year later got admitted at S.E.A.D (Salzburg Experimental Academy of Dance). He got involved in many different projects and worked with choreographers like Todd Williams, Mathew Smith, Oleg Soulimenko, Tuce Tuna, ...

Then, during two years, he continued his education at P.A.R.T.S where he graduated from the Training Cycle in 2010.
